Six Iconic Places in Little India to Visit This Deepavali



As we begin to emerge from the dreary tunnel of 2020's global pandemic, the multicoloured lights of Deepavali are a welcome sight to Singaporeans of all walks of life. With the lamps and banners lining Serangoon Road, we are starting to see the early signs of normalcy returning to our Lion City. This year, the focus of the annual decorations is the Goddess Mahalakshmi, the goddess of prosperity and abundance and the companion of Lord Vishnu. The centerpiece of the decorations features Goddess Mahalakshmi seated on a great lotus with her hand outstretched in *varadamudra*, the gesture of compassion and giving.

While the road ahead of us is still long, there is a myriad of ways to celebrate Deepavali despite the restrictions in place. Here are six must-see places around Little India to visit during the grand festival of lights.



Tuck Into Authentic Cuisine at The Banana Leaf Apolo

There are few things that can get you into the festival spirit like the taste and aroma of local cuisine. And where better to start than Singapore's original banana leaf restaurant: The Banana Leaf Apolo. After its opening in 1974, The Banana Leaf Apolo rocketed to success, much like the lunar mission of its namesake. It quickly became a household name for bringing the ancient Indian tradition of banana leaf dining to our shores. Regular favourites at the restaurant include mouthwatering dishes such as fish head curry, mutton mysore, Apolo chicken masala, and a selection of naan for every palate. There is also a wide variety of vegetarian options if you are on a meat-free diet. If your tastebuds are starting to tingle, then head for the brightly lit, emerald green letters on 54 Race Course Road or their second location at 48 Serangoon Road.

Deepavali is a festival synonymous with lively, kaleidoscopic colours and the street murals speckled around Little India are a fitting sight to behold this season. January 2020 marked the 6th anniversary of the annual ARTWALK Little India, a joint event between LASALLE College of the Arts and Singapore Tourism Board. While the event has come and gone, the murals are still illuminating the walls and alleys today. Starting on Clive Street, just beyond the Indian Heritage Centre, the art trail wraps around to Race Course Road, displaying unique works from some of our talented, homegrown artists. From the charming tradition of parrot fortune telling to the local icon of the tiffin deliveryman, these murals offer insights into Indian and Singaporean culture, both old and new.

Delight Your Senses at Tekka Marketplace

Everyone knows Tekka Market but to leave it off this list would be a travesty. Just the mere mention of its name would bring back a flood of fond memories of the sights, sounds, and sumptuous food there. The hawker and market stalls are a testament to our diversity, offering a taste of every culture's cuisine. Feeling a little bogged down by modern day struggles? Tekka is the perfect place to wind back the clock and experience the Singapore of yesteryear; when wet markets were much more than just a place to buy groceries. While the regular Deepavali events like the Hipster Bazaar may not be running this year, with all that it has to offer, Tekka can still be your one-stop shop for an enjoyable day out in Little India.

Tekka Marketplace is located in Tekka Centre which is a skip across the road from Little India MRT Station.



Discover Singapore's Indian Roots at the Indian Heritage Centre

The breathtaking building along Campbell Lane stands out from its surroundings with a dazzling glass facade, beautiful light features, and lush greenery on its rooftop. The Indian Heritage Centre was opened in 2015 as a celebration of Indian culture in Singapore. Its stunning architecture is both a modern work of art and a tribute to ancient Indian designs. The centre hosts five permanent galleries which tell countless tales of Indian culture and its journey into Southeast Asia. At the moment, the centre has strict COVID regulations in place which all visitors have to abide by. However, it is a small price to pay to experience the wealth of knowledge within its walls. Guided tours are available at 2pm on Saturdays and Sundays with a Mandarin tour available on the second Sunday of each month. If you fancy a solo jaunt, the centre is open from Tuesday to Sunday.

Admire the Technicolour Elegance of the House of Tan Teng Niah

Amidst the tall buildings of Singapore, a fragment of a much simpler time sits in a corner of Kerbau Road. Despite its obscure location, it is definitely not difficult to find. The enchanting 19th-century villa was once home to prominent businessman Tan Teng Niah who owned and operated factories in the area. As the country began to modernise, new developments took over and transformed the world around it. The little house stood stalwart, however, and was restored to its current state in the 1980s. Today, its rainbow-hued panels delight locals and tourists alike. Whether you're there for an impromptu photoshoot or to admire the award-winning architecture, it is definitely worth a visit.

The House of Tan Teng Niah is located at 37 Kerbau Road, just behind Tekka Centre.



Visit Some of Singapore's Historic Hindu Temples

Little India was not always the cultural destination it is today. In fact, it used to be a bustling place of industry with pineapple factories, rattan workshops, and brick kilns throughout the area. Many of the workers here were migrants from India and as they grew in number, they needed a place to worship. From the late 19th century, temples featuring the spectacular Dravidian architecture of South India were built for the local Indian community to practise their faith freely. A walk down Serangoon Road will acquaint you with two of these sacred sites: Sri Srinivasa Perumal Temple and Sri Veeramakaliamman Temple. The first thing to keep an eye out for are the central towers or *gopuram* of the temples. Adorned with intricate statues of deities and painted with vivid colours, it is worth the trip just to see its grandeur in person. However, the interior of the temples is just as splendid and visitors can experience and learn more about the Hindu faith first-hand. When visiting these holy places, keep in mind that each temple has its own guidelines and visitors are expected to adhere to them.

Sri Srinivasa Perumal Temple is located at 397 Serangoon Rd, just a ten-minute walk away from Sri Veeramakaliamman Temple at 141 Serangoon Rd.

This list offers but a few ideas of how to enjoy and explore Little India; many other adventures await to be discovered amidst its storied streets. While the physical markets and bazaars are not on this year, many sellers have taken to online stores and even Facebook where you can buy the festive treats and trinkets you love. SPOTLIGHT:

Mr Samuel Tang, BBM

The Grassroots' Club is set up specially for Grassroots Leaders in recognition of their contributions to community service on a voluntary basis. Every Grassroots Leader has made a positive impact and it is the love for what you do which keeps many of you going day after day, despite the challenges in balancing your personal and professional commitments.

In the blink of an eye, this passion has led Mr Samuel Tang, BBM to serve for 41 years. He started his volunteering journey with the People's Association back in 1979. He is currently the Chairman of the West Coast Community Centre Management Committee (CCMC). As a Grassroots Leader for more than 4 decades, let's find out what volunteering means to him!



1 How did you start volunteering as a Grassroots Leader?

I remember it was an afternoon on a weekend. While watching a group of teenagers playing table tennis at a void deck Community Centre, a PA staff invited me to join the CC's table tennis group. Following that, I joined the newly formed YEC at the void deck CC in 1979.

2 What are the benefits of volunteering to you?

Many volunteers never join with the thoughts of getting benefits from volunteering. Instead of receiving benefits, besides contributing their time and effort, they even contribute financially.

Volunteering brings fun and fulfilment to our lives, connects people to people, advances your career and it is good for our mind and body.

I reckon good networking and friendship could be one of the many benefits. However, through the process, learning to understand and managing different people's expectations are important life skills which we might have benefited without realising it.

3 Why is volunteering important to you?

With many who are busy studying, starting their career or building their family, it can be hard to find time to volunteer.

People choose to volunteer for a variety of reasons. For some, it offers the opportunity to give something back to the community or make a difference to the people around them. For others, it provides a chance to develop new social skills, build on existing experience and knowledge or networking.

It is also important to have the right match on the type of volunteering – Find the Right Fit.

I used to share with some of our new friends who started volunteering to treat volunteering as an important CCA - Co-curricular Activity in our lives, which is an extension to our family and career.

4 What was the most memorable thing that had happened during your course of volunteering?

There were many memorable moments. From working with substance abused youths on rehabilitation, creating programmes which benefit the community to organising targeted events, there were too many to mention.

5 What motivates you to serve for so long?

I reckon friendship with my fellow volunteers have kept me going. Of course, by understanding more and able to help the community better or learning through hands-on experience of the various challenges that I face may be the factors which motivate me to continue to serve.

6 During these years of volunteering, did you meet any setback that make you feel like giving up?

There will definitely be short term setbacks or challenges to tackle in life whether in volunteering, family or career. A happy family and successful career are important contributors to maintaining a happy grassroots experience.

I remember in the mist of my years of community service, there was once a thought of stepping down from all grassroots activities due to an intention of furthering my studies in order to advance my career. However, with the encouragement from some Senior Grassroots Leaders, who were kind and understanding, they suggested for me to go on 'Study Leave' for my 2 years of absence.

I reckon passion in volunteering should be like the continuous flow of water in a river and not like a fire which extinguishes after a while.

7 What words of encouragement would you like to give Grassroots Leaders?

Most Grassroots Leaders may not necessarily have the time; but most will have the heart.

As quoted by Winston Churchill:

"You make a living by what you get. You make a life by what you give."

8 What food will you choose to describe your grassroots experience? Why?

A grassroots experience can be interpreted in different ways by different individuals, much like the taste of a dish depends on individuals' taste buds.

I would describe my grassroots experience to be like the "extremely spicy mala steamboat" which smells good, looks tasty, tastes delicious, but if taken in excess can cause indigestion and bloating.

Like every food, any overdose will be bad for health.

We need to balance our grassroots activities with our other priorities - family and career, which is important to our overall quality of lives.
